

Orchestra Excerpts for NZSSSO 2026 – Clarinet & Bass Clarinet

In addition to your short solo piece, please play the following 4 orchestral excerpts (between the red brackets). If you would like to be considered for Principal Clarinet, please also play Extract 5.

If you do not have an A clarinet, you may play excerpt 1 on Bb clarinet – we have A clarinets available to borrow for the course if necessary.

If you would like to be considered for Bass Clarinet please also include Extract 6 played on Bass Clarinet. (If you do not have your own, we can have an instrument available for the course).

If you play saxophone, please consider submitting the saxophone audition excerpts as well – we will not be recruiting specialist saxophone players as they are only in one piece, and we hope to fill these parts with doublers from within the orchestra. Bass clarinet and tenor sax may be covered by one player.


Please introduce each item before playing.
